This letter is to notify you that Adapture Renewables Inc dba Haynach Solar, LLC , has submitted an application to construct and operate the Haynach Solar Hybrid Project, a 110 MW solar generation and 110 MW battery storage facility near you.

The Applicant is proposing to develop the Haynach Solar Hybrid Project on approximately 1100 acres north of the existing Hooper Solar PV generating project. The property lies between N County Rd 102 and N County Rd 104, and between Lane 8 N and Lane 10 N. The back of this letter has images of the project area, which covers four parcels: 500921100172, 500921200173, 500916300040, and 500922100171.

Tract 1 of the Welch Minor Subdivision according to the plat recorded at Reception No 391282, AND The NW 1/4, less and except the North 30 feet of Section 21, Township 40 North, Range 9 East, N.M.P.M. AND The S1/2, less and except the South 30 feet of Section 16, Township 40 North, Range 9 East, N.M.P.M. AND The N 1/2 and the SE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 40 North, Range 9 East, of the New Mexico Principal Meridian, County of Alamosa, State of Colorado.

The county has reviewed the materials submitted by the application and required by Alamosa County's 1041 permit process and determined that the final application is complete. The Alamosa County Board of Commissioners will hold a Public Hearing and consider this application during their regular meeting on Wednesday, January 14, 2026, beginning at 8:30am in the Commission Chambers at 8900 Independence Way.
